On behalf of the Stevens Point American Legion Baseball Board of Directors, I am pleased to open registration for the upcoming season. The Stevens Point American Legion baseball program is looking forward to the upcoming season to be very competitive and successful.

Players that graduated high school in 2018 shall play for the last American Legion team they played. Players shall not be eligible for transfer and their name must appear on a previously approved Legion roster. If a player was born in 2000 or 2001, that player must play in the Senior Legion Baseball program. Players must be 13 years of age as of January 1, 2019 to be eligible for the Junior Legion Baseball program. Players born in 1999 or before are no longer eligible to play American Legion Baseball.

Like prior seasons, we will again be charging a fee to play. The fee will be \$325 per player and there is no discount for multiple players from the same family. The fee helps with the bus, umpire and uniform costs.

Each player/family is required to do \$200 of fundraising and work 15 shifts either in the concession stand, scorekeeping/announcing or collecting entrance fees for tournaments at the gates. Any additional shifts over the 15 can help offset some of the player fee. These shift opportunities are available during Senior and Junior home games as well as SPASH, Pacelli and SPYBA home baseball games. There will be more information at the preseason player/parent meeting on March 31st at 6PM at Rookies. If a player does not make a team, the \$325 player fee will be refunded in full.

This season we will be limiting the size of both the Junior and Senior team rosters. This means that there is the potential that not all players that tryout will make either of the teams. The coaching staff will be scheduling tryouts in mid to late May or early June. Any player whose high school baseball team is still participating in the WIAA playoffs may tryout, but may not play until his high school team's season concludes.

Players making either of the teams will not be issued a uniform until all the forms, a copy of their driver's license or birth certificate are on file, and the \$325 player fee has been paid in full. Please make sure all forms are filled out completely.

Early registration is encouraged to help with the determination of the number of possible teams, coaches needed and with the ordering of proper equipment and uniform sizing. Deadline date to register is April 30th. Late registrations will be accepted on a case-by-case basis.

Registration Instructions

- 1. Complete the *Registration Form* in its entirety.
 - Include the player's cell phone number as the coaching staff will use text messaging as a main form of communication early in the season.
 - Include an e-mail address for the player as well as for the parents/guardians.
- 2. Complete *Player Indemnification Form 2* in its entirety. Follow the directions on the form.
 - Please remember to get it notarized
- 3. Complete the *Player/Parent Agreement Form*.
- 4. Complete the *Player Information Form.*
- 5. Do not forget to include a copy of the player's driver's license. (If no driver license is available, please bring your original birth certificate to the tryouts to show proof of age).
